INSTRUCTIONS

This table lists minimum ACT or SAT test scores and overall high school GPAs required for a student to be nominated for an Honors Award. To use the table:

1. Determine which test the student took. SAT tests taken prior to February 1, 2016 is referred to as “Old SAT,” tests taken after January 31, 2016 is referred to as “New SAT.”
2. Locate the student’s composite ACT or SAT score (old = Math + Critical Reading + Writing, new = Math + Evidence-Based Reading & Writing).
3. Note the Minimum GPA value associated with that score.
4. If the GPA is equal to or greater than this value, the student can be nominated for an Honors Award.

A tool for assistance in determining eligibility is available on the Washington State Honors Award website at <http://www.k12.wa.us/HonorsAward/pubdocs/2018FinalHAEligibilityTable.xlsx> . Enter the students GPA and highest test score from the same column, hit enter and the status box will read “No HA” if the student does not meet the eligibility criteria or “HA Recipient” if they do.

For example, a student with an old Math SAT of 650, a Critical Reading SAT of 650, and a Written SAT of 650 (prior to February 1, 2016) would have a Total score of 1950. This score requires a minimum GPA of 3.347 to be nominated. A student with a new Math SAT of 645 and an Evidence-Based Reading and Writing of 645 would also require a minimum GPA of 3.347 to be eligible. Similarly, an overall GPA of 3.398 is required to nominate a student with an ACT score of 30. ***Only test scores taken after September 1, 2014, and prior to January 31, 2018, should be considered in determining eligibility.***
