School Mapping Partnerships

- CIPMS Operated by WASPC
- Partners with Schools, OSPI, Police & Fire Agencies
- Improved partnerships with ESDs, Emergency Management, Dispatch Agencies, Risk Managers
- Over 16,000 users
 - 8,000 school and other facility users
 - 7,000 law enforcement users
 - 1,000 fire department users
 - 250 others, including DEMs and dispatchers

Sites

- All Public K12 Schools, approximately 2,100
 - Includes new and remodeled schools, funded via OSPI
 - Includes schools mapped by WASPC but not funded via OSPI
- Small number of private K12 schools
- All Community Colleges
- First 4-Year College just mapped – Heritage University
- Critical Infrastructure and Public Buildings
- “Mapping the Core” concept

Version 7 – Easy Alert

- Easy Alert Module – Only available for
 - 7 Pilot School Districts, 47 schools, funded by OSPI Grants
 - Heritage University
 - (7 Counties)
- Features
 - Works on any device
 - Alerts to Dashboard
 - Alerts to pre-set email and text addresses
 - Transmit
 - Text
 - Lat/Long
 - Photos
 - Join event in progress

Funding

- Operations budget
 - \$500,000 per year, funded since 2009
- Capital Budget
 - Provisos in capital budgets provide mapping funding for *new and remodeled schools* which are funded in part by OSPI
 - Funding calculated at \$0.16 per square foot
- Sites can identify own funding – for example,
 - Hospitals
 - Private schools
