<b>Push to Check</b>	<a href="http://www.push2check.net">www.push2check.net</a>	Checks different parameters for domains and subdomains – saves history, so you can track changes to a site. Meta-search engine for analysis of a webpage
<b>IP-address.com</b>	<a href="http://www.ip-adress.com/ip_tracer/">www.ip-adress.com/ip_tracer/</a> (not a typo in address)	IP tracer and IP locator
<b>Verify Email</b>	<a href="http://www.verify-email.org">www.verify-email.org</a>	Enter an email to verify whether the mailbox exists or not
<b>Ip2location</b>	<a href="http://www.ip2location.com">www.ip2location.com</a>	Identify location & identity of an unknown IP address

<b>Internet Archive</b>	<a href="https://archive.org">https://archive.org</a>	Stores open source movies, music, books, etc. Also access WayBackMachine – search for archived copies of web pages. Clicking on links takes you to the archived edition – no direct link to page means you remain anonymous
