We encourage all personnel who have safety and security duties, including any school personnel who manage such programs and School Resource Officers to consider participation. Feedback from previous participants includes that they appreciate the legal and best practice guidance provided on issues involving school safety/security policies and procedures, freedom of speech, search and seizure, drug trends, threat assessment, use of force, gang issues, suicide prevention, communication skills, patrol procedures, tactical planning using the Rapid Responder computer system, and methods for essential documentation. Courses are regularly updated by instructors to promote state-of-the-art practices. **Participants can expect to start at 0800 hrs and end at 1630 hrs each day.**
