### The Olweus Bullying Prevention Program

The OBPP is an evidence-based program that

**Reduces** bullying among K-12 students,

**Improves** the social climate of classrooms,

**Reduces** antisocial behaviors, such as vandalism and truancy,

**Increases** achievement, and

**Aligns** with many Common Core standards.



### Certification Process

**Attend** a 3-day Trainer Certification Course (TCC) Part 1 to become provisionally certified

**Consult** with an Olweus Technical Assistance Consultant for 24 months

**Train** bullying prevention coordinating committees and provide regular consultation to them as they implement the OBPP

**Attend** a 2-day TCC Part 2 approximately one year after the Part 1 training

**Participate** in online learning to stay up-to-date on current research and practice

### Trainer-Consultant Responsibilities

**Consult** with schools to help determine readiness to implement the OBPP

**Conduct** 2-day trainings of school committees

**Guide** bullying prevention coordinating committees as they train all staff

**Consult** monthly with the committee as they implement the OBPP
