Beginning in 1995–96 a portion of students with disabilities served in the special education program are not deducted from enrollment reported on Report P-223. Certificated instructional staffing funding ratios differ from actual ratios for the following reasons:

- Funded ratios were between a minimum of 49.0 and a maximum of 53.2.
- Classified instructional aide staff generated a maximum of 1.3 of the certificated instructional staff funding ratio.
- Funded ratios as shown here do not include any small school bonus staff units.
- Enrollment periods used in the calculation of the staff to student ratios may be selected by school districts and may differ among school districts.
